Gladys Cram - Dr. Stone's assistant

Mr. Hawes - curate, suffering from sleeping sickness

Mrs. Price-Ridley - gossipy widow that notices missing collection money

Bill Archer - poacher sent to jail by Colonel Protheroe

Raymond West - nephew of Miss Marple
