

Volunteer Program Policy

- 1. Volunteer applicants interested in the shelving position are required to be at least 15 years old. Reading and accurate alphabetizing skills are necessary for shelving tasks.
- 2. Applicants between 12-18 years old may apply for the Volunteen position. Please refer to the position description for information about the duties.
- 3. All potential volunteers must complete an application prior to being allowed to volunteer at the library. The library reserves the right to deny volunteer opportunities to any person.
- 4. Volunteers will be subject to a background and/or reference check.
- 5. The library may inform a volunteer at any time and for any reason that they may no longer volunteer at the library. The library need not specify a reason.
- 6. Volunteers must:
 - Be respectful of staff, patrons, and their surroundings.
 - Perform assigned tasks as requested.
 - Show up for assigned hours if the task requires a specific time—please remember that we are counting on you.
 - Perform tasks correctly—please ask if you have questions or concerns.
- 7. The library will contact approved volunteers to set up an interview, orientation, and training. If you have further questions, please contact the volunteer coordinator at 920-886-6321. Thank you!
